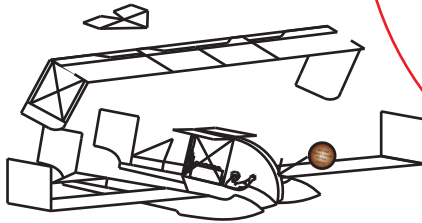

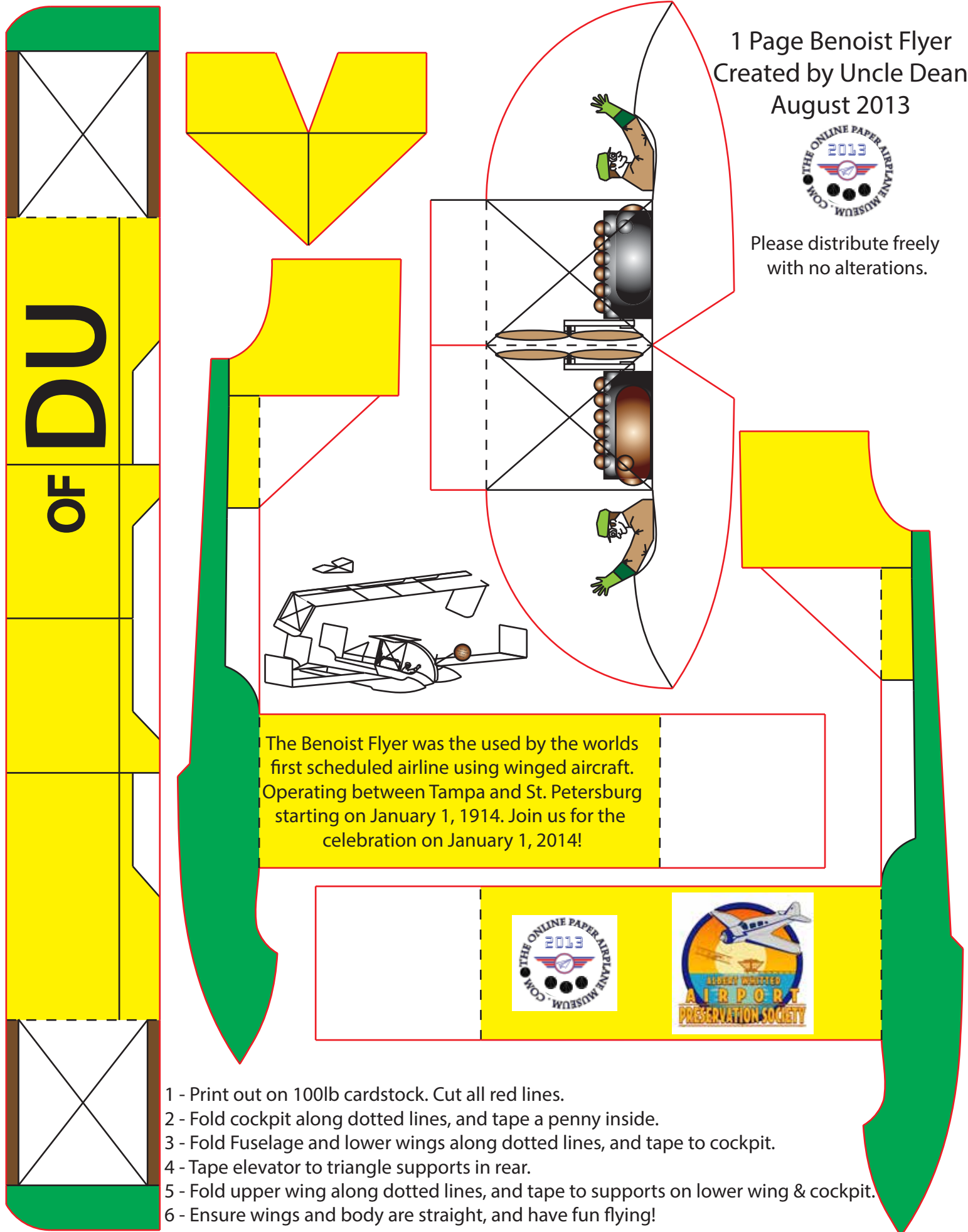


- 1 - Print out on 100lb cardstock. Cut all red lines.
