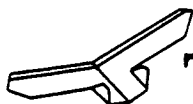


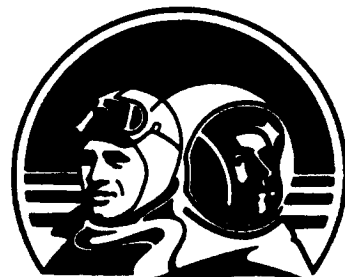
You'll need:

Try making these changes:

1. Put the rear fins up for a more durable plane.
2. Put the rear fins down for more stability during flight.
3. Tape the leading edge roll under the

- wing for livelier flights.
4. Tape the leading edge roll on top of the wing for longer flights.
5. To solve turning problems, twist leading edge of wing near center.
