



This is the original size of the plane, top of the plane.

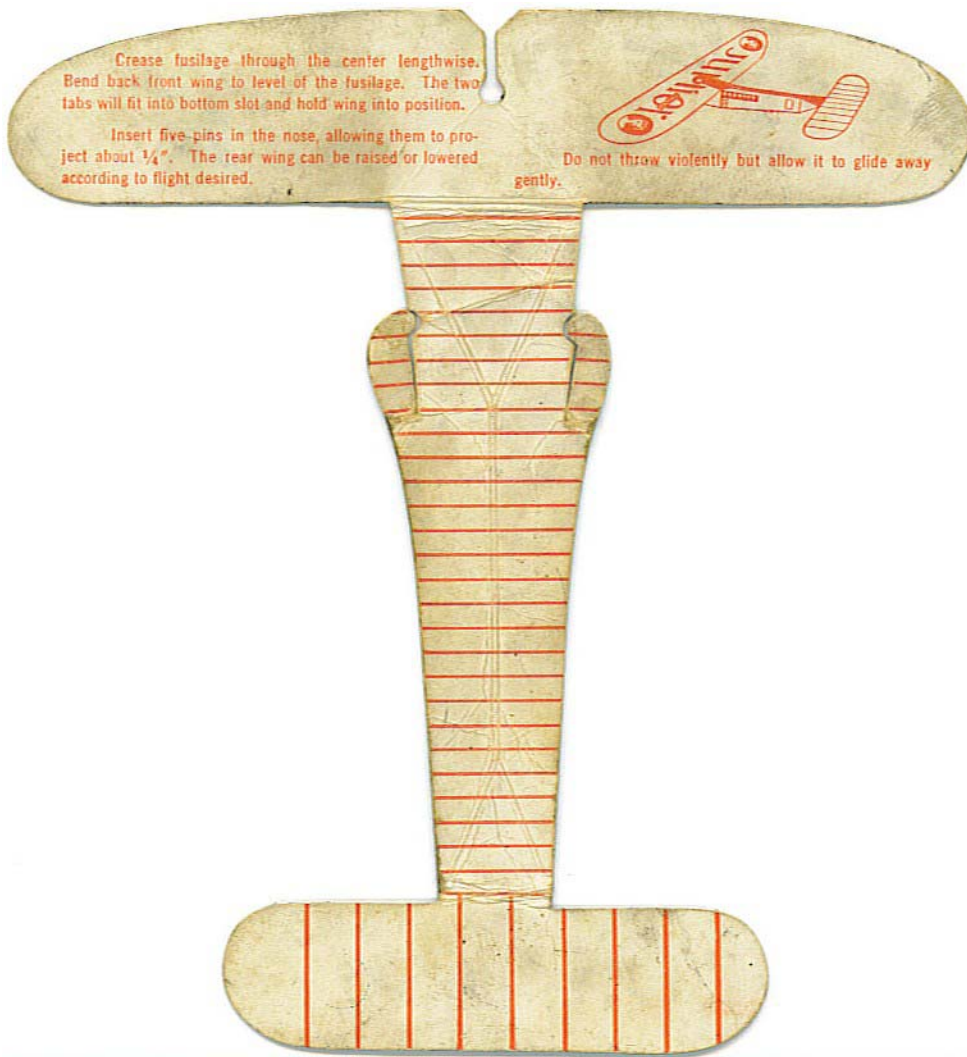
The Directions on the reverse read

“Crease fuselage through the center lengthwise.

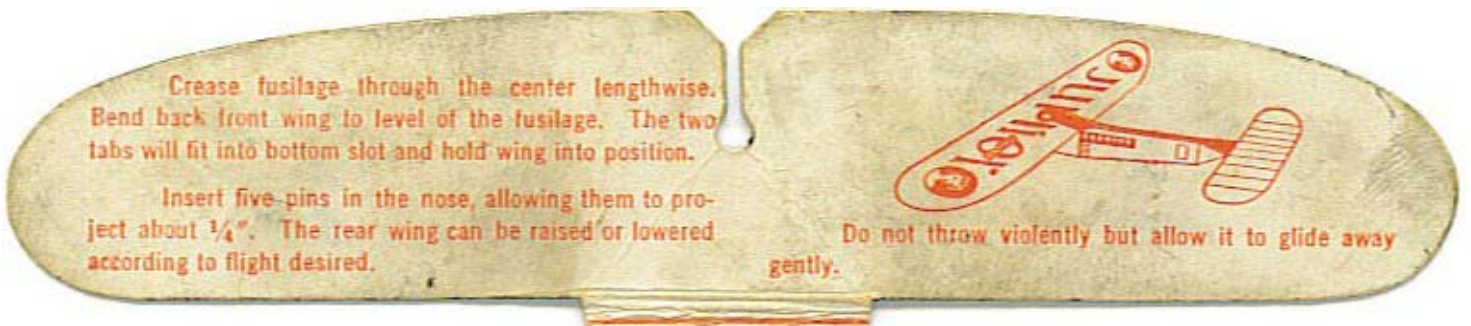
Bend back front wing to level of the fuselage. The two
Tabs will fit into bottom slot and hold wing into position.”

“Insert five pins in the nose, allowing them to project
about $\frac{1}{4}$ ”. The rear wing can be raised or lowered
according to flight desired.”

“Do not throw violently but allow it to glide away gently”

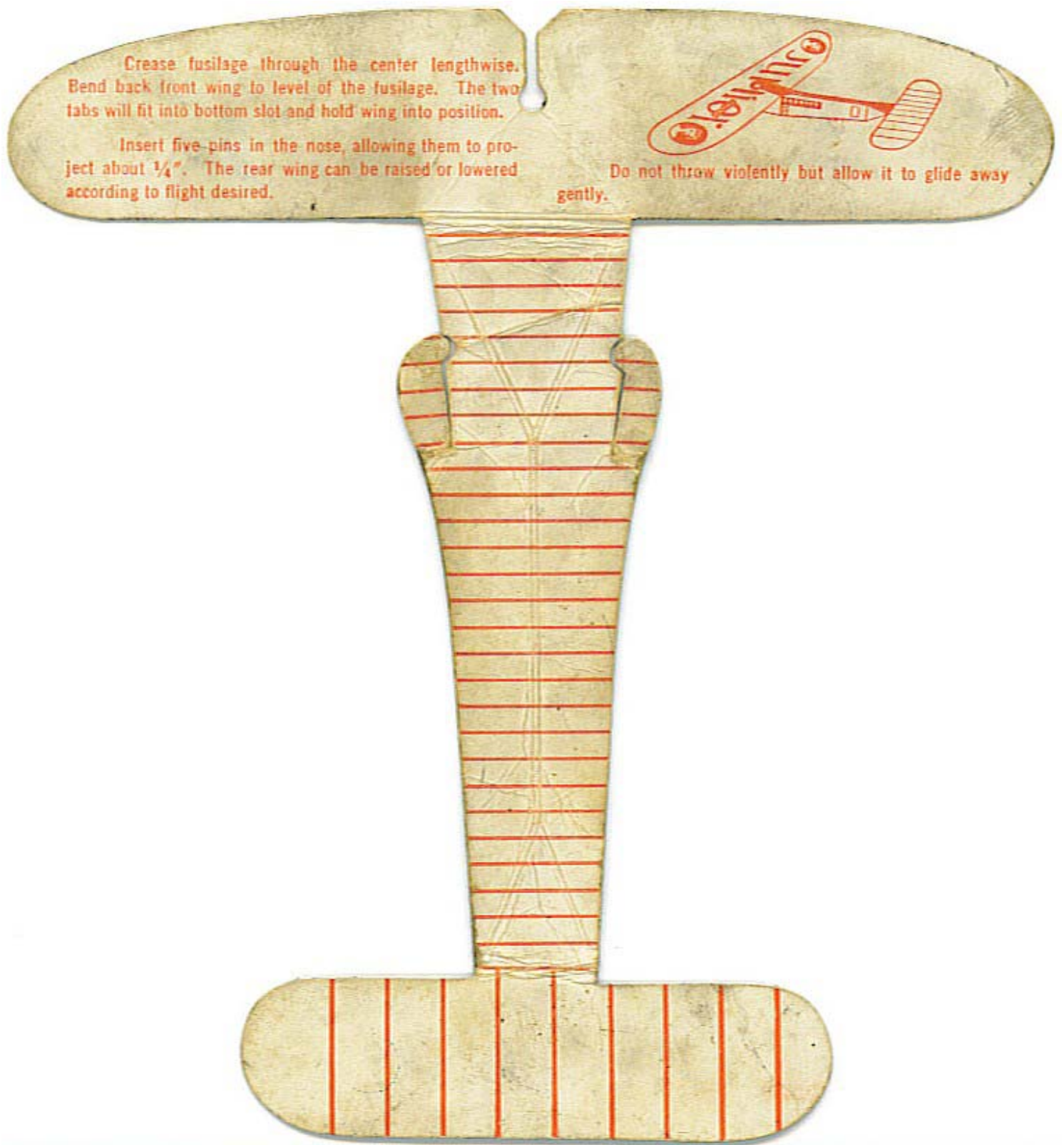


This is the original size of the plane, the underside with directions.

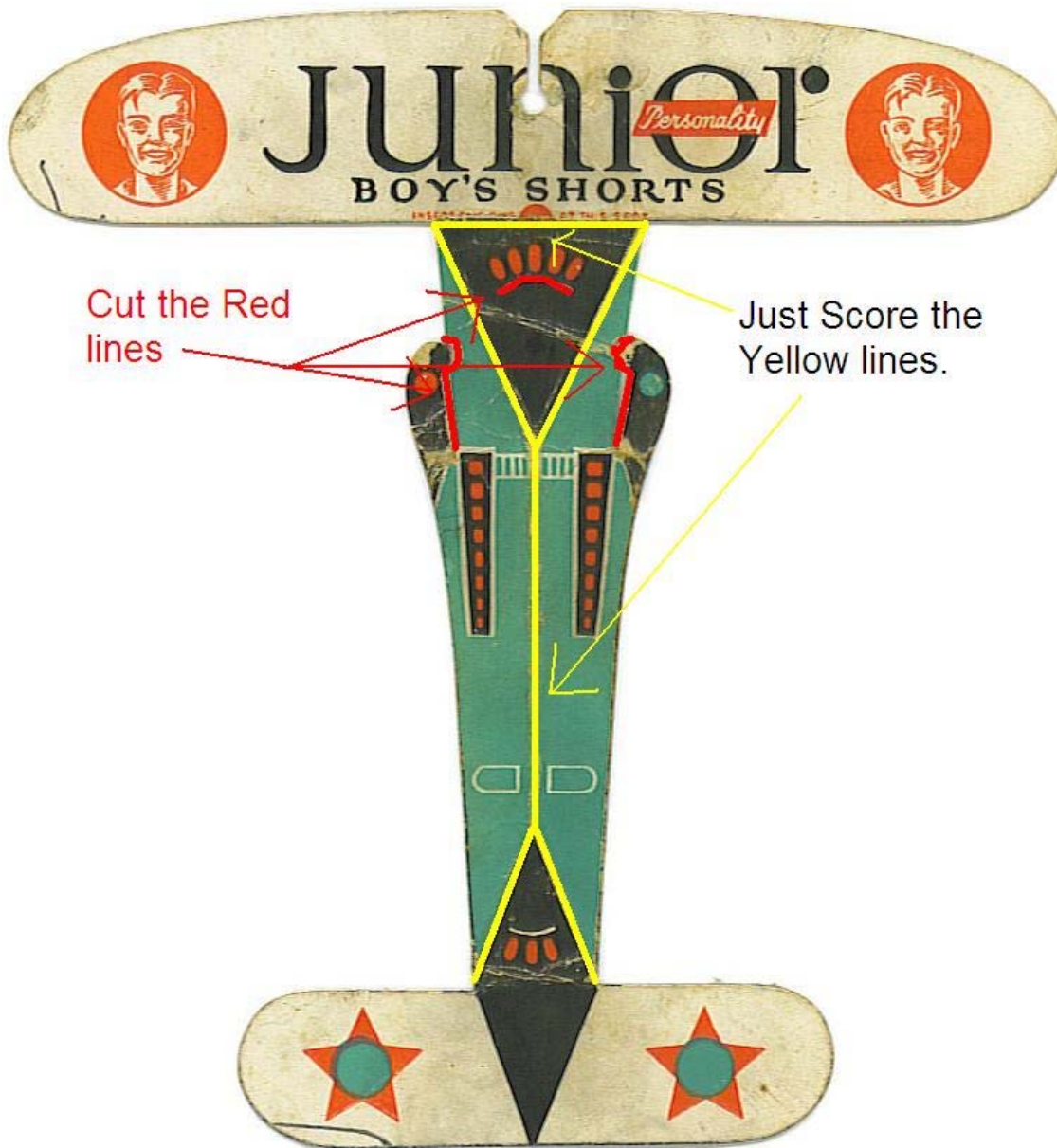




This is an enlarged version of the plane, top view.



This is an enlarged version of the plane, underside view, with directions.



When cutting out, make sure to cut around the tabs as shown in red, and score the yellow lines (don't cut all the way thru) it will make it easier to bend the plane along the correct lines.

Instead of using pins, I used a standard paper clip on the smaller planes, and 2 paper clips in the larger planes. I insert them into the half circle that was cut in the black triangle area.
